The advantages of a child care center is that you have a licensed center that you know is supervised; that you have trained and experienced caregivers; and that there is a community. It's set up and designed for babies. It's nurturing, we have cribs set up for each individual baby. We have toys that are appropriate for babies and it's focused on one on one interaction, a lot of holding
