Figuring out how much your baby weighs in pounds

Many small babies are weighed on a scale that uses grams and not pounds. Use this chart to figure out how much your baby weighs in pounds. First, find the number of grams that is closest to your baby's weight. Then read across to find the number of pounds your baby weighs.

If you want to know your baby's exact weight, take their weight in grams and multiply it by 0.0022. For example, if your baby weighs 950 grams, then you would multiply 950 x 0.0022.Your baby's weight in pounds would be 2.09 pounds.

Ask your nurse if you're not sure about your baby's weight.
