A dry powder inhaler (DPI) is a device that delivers medication to the lungs in the form of a dry powder.

This medication should never be used as a rescue medication.

Advair, Flovent and Serevent are some of the DPI Diskus asthma medications most commonly used.

When taking dry powder inhalers, you may not taste, smell, or feel the dry powder. But don't worry, as long as you're following the directions, you'll get your full dose of medication.
