An opposite-sex attraction is another. We don't fully understand the factors that shape these feelings. They're part of who we are.

Lesbians are a diverse group. They express themselves in different ways. Some are private. For others, being a lesbian is a public part of who they are. Deciding how to identify and how to live is personal and complex. Every person must decide what's right for them.
