






What Does an Endocrinologist Do?







Overview

What do they treat?

To find out what's wrong, your endocrinologist looks at a range of factors. They give you a physical exam. They study your health history. They may order different types of tests. They use all of this info to develop a care plan that's right for you.

A big part of an endocrinologist's job is sharing info with you. So they teach you about your condition. They make sure you know about all of your care options. They explain how these options affect you. They help you during treatment, and give you the support you need as you recover. And they create a plan to help you live a healthy life.
