They can show you different breastfeeding positions. They can help you get your baby to latch. They teach you how to deal with things like sore nipples and issues with your milk supply. And they can help you learn to pump your breastmilk.

Support and encouragement

Lactation consultants aren't just for first-time parents. They can help you even if you've breastfed other babies. You can see a consultant before you give birth. And they can give you support for several months after your baby is born, if you need it.
